

- Additional bus services (by JR Hokkaido Bus) are operated between Subway Tozai Line Maruyama Koen Station (Maruyama Koen Bus Terminal)-the Entrance of Maruyama Zoo-the Entrance of Okurayama Jumping hill. It takes appx.15 minutes.

Outward trip: 7th Jan. (Sat.) 14:00-17:00, 8th Jan. (Sun.) 8:00-10:30

Return trip: From the entrance of the jumping hill after the competitions

Bus fares: Free of charge.

- Maruyama Koen Station (Tozai Line) is the closest subway station.

To get to the Bus Terminal, go out of the ticket gates, walk through the underground passage, and go up the stairs (a few minutes' walk).

- If you walk up the hill from Maruyama Koen Station, it takes approximately 45 minutes to reach Okurayama (distance: 3 km)

By car

By bus and subway

Bus fares: Adult ¥210 Children ¥110. Transfer fares and IC cards can be used.

For the Snow Brand Megmilk Cup scheduled on 12th February, bus fare is free of charge and temporary parking place will be provided. Please check the details on the official event site (currently under construction).

Okurayama and Miyanomori Jumping hills are situated appx. 6 - 7 km west of central Sapporo. During the events, parking in the area is very limited and we encourage you to travel here via public transport. The distance between Okurayama and Miyanomori is about 2 km.
